No late registrations will be accepted.


If the provider cancels games or tournaments depending on their refund policy you will be refunded/credited accordingly.

Teaching & Learning **Together**

The Māori concept of Ako is integral to life at GHS.

You may remember, at the start of the year, we talked about Pink to Think & Gold for Glory.

In the Purapura Whānau, this is how we

introduce our children to Ako.

Blue means Blue to Do-that I growth & development as learners.

In the Purapura Whānau, we take a progressional approach that encourages our tamariki to deepen their awareness of Ako as they move from Year 1, to Year 2.

You might hear older children talk about 'Blue to Do'. This is the next step in Ako- remembering to bring all the skills you know to the teaching & learning.

Ako is a big concept for our tamariki, so we are focus our use of this idea during our Structured Literacy time.

WHAT IS STRUCTURED LITERACY?

The systematic & explicit teaching of reading & writing skills.

- Better Start Literacy Approach
- Heggerty or Yolanda Soryl Phonics
- A mix of Whole Class & Small Group work
- Link our Reading & Writing to our Inquiry to motivate & inspire the tamariki!



FUTURE FOOTBALL SUPERSTARS!






